**EXPERT VIEW:** Danzart should prove popular in a bid to land a double dropped back to 6f after a narrow victory over 7f here last month. He's a three time winner over six furlongs so must be feared but 7f looks his optimum trip now and the combination of drop in trip and 4lb rise makes it tough and he's taken on. ONE MORE DREAM looks the solid option. He won a 5f event at Pontefract when returned to turf last month for the first time in a while exploiting his much lower turf mark and is back on turf off a 3lb higher mark having gone well switched to the AW last time. The step back up to 6f should be fine and the son of Bated Breath can score again. Captain Vello is in good spirits and back over his optimum trip can make the frame
