Nigel Tinkler's gelding was beaten under a length last time trying 1m2f for the first time and saw out the trip well. He lacked a touch of pace then but in this company has less to fear on that count. He should be in the shake-up. That also applies to Calibos who saw out the extened 1m1f last time at Wolverhampton and it would take only a modicum of improvement to land this. There's a chance he'd prefer some cut but as long as it's not rattling has every chance of another bold bid. Carlyle Square is feared. Although she's yet to get within 8l of the winner in three runs she's shown enough in better company to suggest an opening mark of 58 is reasonable and if taking to turf looks a likely improver who can go close
