He flattened out that day but was beaten under two lengths and perhaps most of the improvement next time was down to natural progression not just the drop back to 5f. This is only his second turf run (poor on debut on soft ground) but he remains well-handicapped and can lead them home. Alashos looks best placed to expolit any frailties of the selection. James Horton's gelding flopped badly last time when favourite but it may pay to excuse that effort as he seemed to resent the first-time blinkers holding his head high and never travelled.
