EXPERT VIEW: TAKE A BREATH looks to have been handed a gilt edged opportunity by the handicapper and is fancied to kick of his season in style and claim top spot. Form figures of 435 are a bit misleading consisdering he was beaten less than a length the last twice and only six lengths by Sandtrap (second in a French G2 next time) on debut. Native Honey was unfancied on season debut last time and a 6th of 8 looks pretty unininspiring but he was denied a clear run at a critical stage and his winning chance vanished. He may have gone close. Better is expected eased back in grade off a further 2lb drop. Patsy Snugfit is another to have endured a miserable time of it late on last time when squeezed out by the first two and slipping back to fifth. She wouldn't have been beaten far. A close-up third on her debut last term bodes well for her season bow today and she can make the frame

Perry Mason may be a danger having run well on his only start, but that was a year ago and he doesn't want the ground too quick given his high action. He may need this and Competizione may beat him. The Gosden colt got unbalanced in the Dip at Newmarket on his debut and is open to plenty of improvement. R P McMurphy is also one to watch a half-brother to the very good sprinter Danzeno.

EXPERT VIEW: Danzart should prove popular in a bid to land a double dropped back to 6f after a narrow victory over 7f here last month. He's a three time winner over six furlongs so must be feared but 7f looks his optimum trip now and the combination of drop in trip and 4lb rise makes it tough and he's taken on. ONE MORE DREAM looks the solid option. He won a 5f event at Pontefract when returned to turf last month for the first time in a while exploiting his much lower turf mark and is back on turf off a 3lb higher mark having gone well switched to the AW last time. EXPERT VIEW: This probably hinges on whether TRUST SERGEI can prove as effective back up in trip having opened his account when dropped back to a sharp 5f. There's no doubt stamina concerns, as he faded away on his first three career runs between 6f and 7f before a more promising 3rd on handicap debut in a 6f event. He flattened out that day but was beaten under two lengths and perhaps most of the improvement next time was down to natural progression not just the drop back to 5f. This is only his second turf run (poor on debut on soft ground) but he remains well-handicapped and can lead them home. Alashos looks best placed to expolit any frailties of the selection. James Horton's gelding flopped badly last time when favourite but it may pay to excuse that effort as he seemed to resent the first-time blinkers holding his head high and never travelled. Now with cheekpieces (worn three previous runs) replacing the offending blinkers he can get back on track. Rogue Dancer and Moby Quick are respected but Chuti Manika is next on the list having made a very encouraging season bow last time when narrowly touched off again (has been beaten less than a length last three runs now). Charlie Johnston's colt is dependable and shouldn't be far away

EXPERT VIEW: BAS BLEU has a good opportunity to gain his first win on turf having kicked off this term with a fine third beaten less than a length at Kempton following on form a win at the same venue on final run last term. Before that he proved at least as effective on turf and a bit of improvement can be reasonably expected on this second run of the season. He should prove tough to master. Melek Alreeh was in top form when last seen in November landing a class 5 handicap for a second win at Southwell. On balance his AW form is a bit better than on turf but he's less exposed on grass and his only other win came over CD on fast ground on second career start. He can go very well fresh and is greatly feared. Squeezbox has cliams back at his optimum trip but may struggle a bit upped in class so Isle Of Stark may prove more of a danger returned to Flat action having been campaigned over jumps this winter. The pick of his Flat form offers hope and off a career low mark he can make his presence felt
